Dear Parents and Guardians

Greetings from Rishikul Sanatan College.

Parents and Guardians please take note of the important reminders.

1.0 Mid-Year Examination

- 1.1 The Mid Year Examination will be carried out in week 4. Parents/Guardians are reminded to monitor and support their children in their revision and preparation for exams.
- 1.2 **It is compulsory for students to arrive in the morning by 8.00am for all exams and depart at the end of the school day. No late arrivals and early departures will be entertained during internal exams.**
- 1.3 For years 12 and 13, the mid-year exams are important as students will use these results for preliminary applications for tertiary institutes.
- 1.4 Parents/Guardians to ensure that children are in school on time to sit the exams.

2.0 Parents Day

- 2.1 The College will be having parent's day on **26th August from 8.00am to 3.00pm.**
- 2.2 Students will accompany parents from home in proper school uniform and after discussions with teachers; students will leave with parents to go home. Parents/guardians are reminded that they bring their child/ward in order to have fruitful discussions with teachers.
- 2.3 It is the parents/guardians responsibility to ensure that they bring their child and ensure that the child/ward safely goes home after discussions with the teachers.
- 2.4 **Only parents or Legal Guardians will be allowed to sight Report cards and have discussions with teachers regarding the child's performance.**
- 2.5 Thus parents and Guardians are humbly requested to take out time to avail themselves for this important discussion.

3.0 Parent's Responsibility

- 3.1 Parents/Guardians are urged to take ownership and responsibility in ensuring that children have basic manners and values.

- 3.2 Parents need to monitor that children reach school on time and go home on time after school. Despite reminders, students are still seen loitering and playing in school uniform outside of school after 4pm. As parents ensure that these are not normal times due to the COVID pandemic and we all need to look after the welfare of children.
- 3.3 Parents /Guardians need to devote time in counseling children at home as there is an increase in student indiscipline and this causes disruption in the teaching learning program in school and teachers are engaged in correcting student's behavioral problems.
- 3.4 We seek parents/guardians cooperation in correcting a child's wrong behavior that so students display the appropriate behavior in and out of school.

4.0 Use of social media

- 4.1 Children's usage of social media needs to be monitored by parents. Quality time must be spent with children ensuring that children spend time doing constructive work. Home supervision is vital and parents/ Guardians must discourage the abuse of social media so that children can focus on education.

5.0 School Rules

School rules and Code of Conduct is a guideline that ensures correct and proper behavior of students.

Parents are reminded that all school rules apply till the last day of school, therefore monitor and ensure that your child follows these rules and do not get involved in disciplinary issues as this will have an adverse effect on your child's learning. It is our humble request that we all stand by the rules of the College so that students attain the best academic and lifelong education from this institute.


6.0 Conclusion
