## Newsletter 2 - Term 2

Dear Parents and Guardians

Greetings from Rishikul Sanatan College.

Parents and Guardians please take note of the important reminder in regards to <u>Inflation</u>

<u>Mitigation Assistance for children.</u>

### A. Eligibility and Criteria

- 1. Families earning less than \$50,000 in combined annual household income will receive \$180 per child over a 6 month period.
- 2. Students in year 13 and below who are currently receiving subsidized transportation assistance can fill out a simple manual form that calls for details for MPAISA/MYCASH account details to receive assistance.
- 3. Families earning below \$50,000 annually whose children do not receive transport assistance can apply through the same manual application or online through the Inflation Mitigation Application System. <a href="https://assistance.digitalfiji.gov.fi">https://assistance.digitalfiji.gov.fi</a>
- 4. Those parents who do wish to apply manually can apply online. The online application will open from 19<sup>th</sup> August.
- 5. Those parents whose children are not receiving transport assistance need to fill in **Section D** of the application form for income verification by one of the third parties listed in Section D.
- 6. The application form will gather parent's details and phone number for payment. Correct parents details must be written in the form.
- 7. The phone number detail given must have MPAISA/MYCASH account as students will receive payment through this. Only one (1) phone number must be given.
- 8. All information given by parents must be properly verified and declared as true prior to submitting the forms back to the school.

- 9. All data will be verified by the school (Name of parent, Phone contact and Section D of income verification) before the details are entered on FEMIS.
- 10. Head of school will only update data on FEMIS once all details provided on the form meets the requirements.

### B. Timeline and Deadlines

- **11.** The forms will be available from the school office from 15<sup>th</sup> August. Filled forms must be returned to the school office.
- 12. All applications close on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and final payment will be done on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022.
- 13. The Ministry of Education will submit application data as follows for processing:

First Batch – 26<sup>th</sup> August Third Batch – 15<sup>th</sup> September Second Batch – 9<sup>th</sup> September Final Batch – 30<sup>th</sup> September

14. Applications received by Ministry of Economy on 26<sup>th</sup> August will be paid out by 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Forms received by 9<sup>th</sup> September will be paid by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022. Remaining will be paid by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and the remaining applications will be paid by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022.
